

Present simple

Examples

I go to work 5 days a week

I have 3 sisters




He always drinks coffee for breakfast

I don't like movies

Cheetahs run very fast

Do you eat meat?

Structure

	I go to work every day (SUBJECT – I, you, they, we) + (VERB) He goes to work every day (SUBJECT – he, she, it) + (VERB s or es)
	I don't go to work every day (SUBJECT – I, you, they, we) + don't + (VERB) she doesn't go to work every day (SUBJECT – he, she, it) + doesn't + (VERB)
	Do you go to work every day? do + (SUBJECT – I, you, they, we) + (VERB) Does she go to work every day? does + (SUBJECT – I, you, they, we) + (VERB)

SUBJECT = who we are talking about

I, you, he, she, it, they, we.

It can be a name e.g. Donald Trump

VERB = The 'doing' word

Here we use the BASE FORM.

e.g. play, run, write, make, do, sing

When we use present simple

- Regular actions
I usually play football at the weekend
I go to the gym every Friday
- Facts or states
Rabbits eat carrots
I live in London
